## Camp Information

### Elite Hockey Program

Michigan State hockey is among the top programs in the nation. The Spartans have claimed multiple national titles, been to the NCAA tournament on more than 20 occasions and lead the CCHA in wins and playoff titles. In addition, more than 30 All-Americans have donned the Green and White, and more than 50 have used Michigan State as a stepping stone to a career in the National Hockey League.

### Camp Curriculum

The Spartan Hockey Curriculum is designed for the travel hockey player. It is a fast moving, high tempo program that pushes the player to higher levels of play. It covers every aspect of the game both offensively and defensively. It is designed for the player that has a desire to play the highest level of hockey available to them. It is structured to work fundamentals and team skills in a highly competitive environment that allows our staff to evaluate player's talents.

On Sunday, a mandatory meeting will take place in the stands of Munn Arena at 5:00 p.m. Players will go on ice for one hour on Sunday with age groups beginning at 5:30 p.m. Check-out will occur following each group's final game on Thursday afternoon.

Each participant should have his or her own medical insurance. A student trainer will always be available. Participants are automatically enrolled in MSU's accident insurance plan. Eligible covered expenses will be paid only if they are in excess of other valid and collectible insurance. No physicals are required.
